

MALE UNDRESS, SHORT SLEEVE

COVER—Standard cover with Marine Corps Insignia. Associate Members wear the sunburst ornament in place of the Marine Corps Insignia. The Military Order of the Devil Dog patch is worn on the right side of the cover (when authorized) in accordance with MODD regulations.

DEVIL DOG COLLAR (optional) - To be worn around the neck under the collar.

NAME TAG (optional) - Is worn 1/8" above the right pocket.

COLLAR ORNAMENT-

The sunburst ornament is worn on both collars, with the anchors facing inboard.

SHIRT-

White with open collar. Aviator style with two pockets, military creases, button down flaps and epaulets.

RIBBONS-

To be either Marine Corps League or Department of Defense ribbons (and authorized devices) but not mixed. To be worn 1/8" above the left pocket.

SHOULDER PATCHES-

The Marine Corps League shoulder patch is worn on the left sleeve 1-1/2" from the shoulder seam. Associate Members wear the same patch with a rocker which says "Associate Member" below the league patch.



The Marine Corps League expects all members to wear the uniform proudly and correctly. Remember that, while we're no longer on active duty, we are still Marines!

U.S. FLAG PATCH-

Is to be worn on the right sleeve 1-1/2 inches from the shoulder seam.

MODD SHOULDER PATCH-

Is to be worn in place of the U.S. flag patch by members of the Order, 1-1/2 inches from the shoulder seam.

TROUSERS-

Either USMC dress blue with red stripe or black without cuffs or pleats.

BELT-

Khaki belt with open brass buckle to be worn with dress blue trousers or a black belt with the gold square Marine Corps buckle when black trousers are worn.

SOCKS-

Black.

SHOES-

Black, with plain toe.
